TO: Prospective Proposing Firms and all others concerned

DATE: September 17, 2024

PURPOSE: To provide additional information and clarification to the solicitation documents for the above-referenced Project.

1. The following questions and answers are provided for additional clarification to the RFP. All answers from Thornton in response to Vendor submitted questions have been provided in **bold** text.

Question # 1: Will Thornton extend the Due Date in the Schedule of Events from September 30th at 11:00 pm MDT, to a new date and time of October 11th at 11:00 am MDT? There is a short turnaround time from receiving answers to Vendor questions from Thornton and the September 30th coincides with our quarter end closing.

Answer # 1: No. Thornton does not anticipate needing to extend the Due Date in the current schedule of events.

Question # 2: Can Thornton provide details or a link to local business considerations for this RFP?

Answer # 2: The evaluation criteria for this RFP is listed within Section E.12 – Evaluation Criteria, of the main RFP. A local business consideration is not included in the evaluation criteria for this RFP.

Question # 3: When reading Section B.5 – ESRI Integration from the RFP, how important is it to Thornton that ESRI certify a responding Vendor as an integration partner?

Answer # 3: The City uses ERSI, and the Vendor's product must be able to consume ESRI data into the system and/or be able to export into ESRI. Ideally, this product could integrate with a 2-way sync.

Question # 4: Can Thornton provide further detail on initial licensing requirements across the following user types?

- Full edit and creation users
- Read Only, reporting, and tracing users
- True View Only users
- Mobile users

Answer # 4: See below.

- **Full edit and creation users – Two (2) user licenses;**
- **Read Only, reporting, and tracing users – Five (5) user licenses;**
- **True View Only users – Ten (10) user licenses; and**
- **Mobile users – Six (6) user licenses for power users of the system, but is dependent on the mobile features that the Vendor’s solution can provide.**

2. All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged except as provided by this Addendum. Proposing firms must acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in their Proposal.
